ABOUT THE WORKSHOP

The Workshop is an immersion program for adult amateurs in the study of string quartet literature. We offer a challenging yet supportive environment where participants will 1) study two works, assigned in advance, under the guidance of a professional coach (for possible performance); 2) enlarge their knowledge of the literature and sharpen their sight-reading skills through supervised reading sessions with different groups; and 3) play music of their choice in informal "pick-up" sessions each evening. Enrollment is limited, so interested musicians are encouraged to submit applications as soon as possible. A \$100.00 deposit must be included, which will be refunded if we cannot place an applicant. The deadline is **April 15**, after which we can only consider an application if there is a remaining vacancy; participants will be notified of acceptance and assignments by early May. The dormitory will open at noon, and the Workshop begins at 6:00 p.m. on June 19 and ends at 12:30 p.m. on June 23 (if absolutely necessary, participants may leave late in the evening of June 22, with advance notice). **For complete information, please visit our website: www.gettysburgchambermusic.org**

FIRST TIME APPLICANTS

New applicants must submit a list of works studied or performed (solo or chamber), a sample of your playing (CD, cell-phone video, YouTube or Dropbox link, etc.), or an actual audition with a faculty member. FACILITIES

Housing and all musical activities will take place in Haaland Hall on the campus of Gettysburg College, Gettysburg, Pennsylvania. It features air conditioned, single-occupancy bedrooms (with free Wi-fi), arranged in suites. Meals are taken in the College dining hall, which involves some walking. Some college recreational facilities are also available for use by participants.

COSTS

The total cost is \$650.00, which includes a private room, all meals, and coaching. Commuting musicians may attend for \$425.00.
